

Leadership Oklahoma City Distinguished Leadership Award - 2010

The Alumni Board annually has the honor of being able to nominate an LOKC (dues paying) graduate for the Community Leadership Association's Distinguished Leadership Award (DLA). The DLA is recognized at the Community Leadership Association's annual conference and presented a trophy and a cash award of \$3500 (to be donated to their nonprofit of choice) at our LOKC graduation in May.

The DLA is designed to recognize exceptional community leadership program graduates. Recipients are men and women who have made significant and notable contributions for the betterment of their communities.
