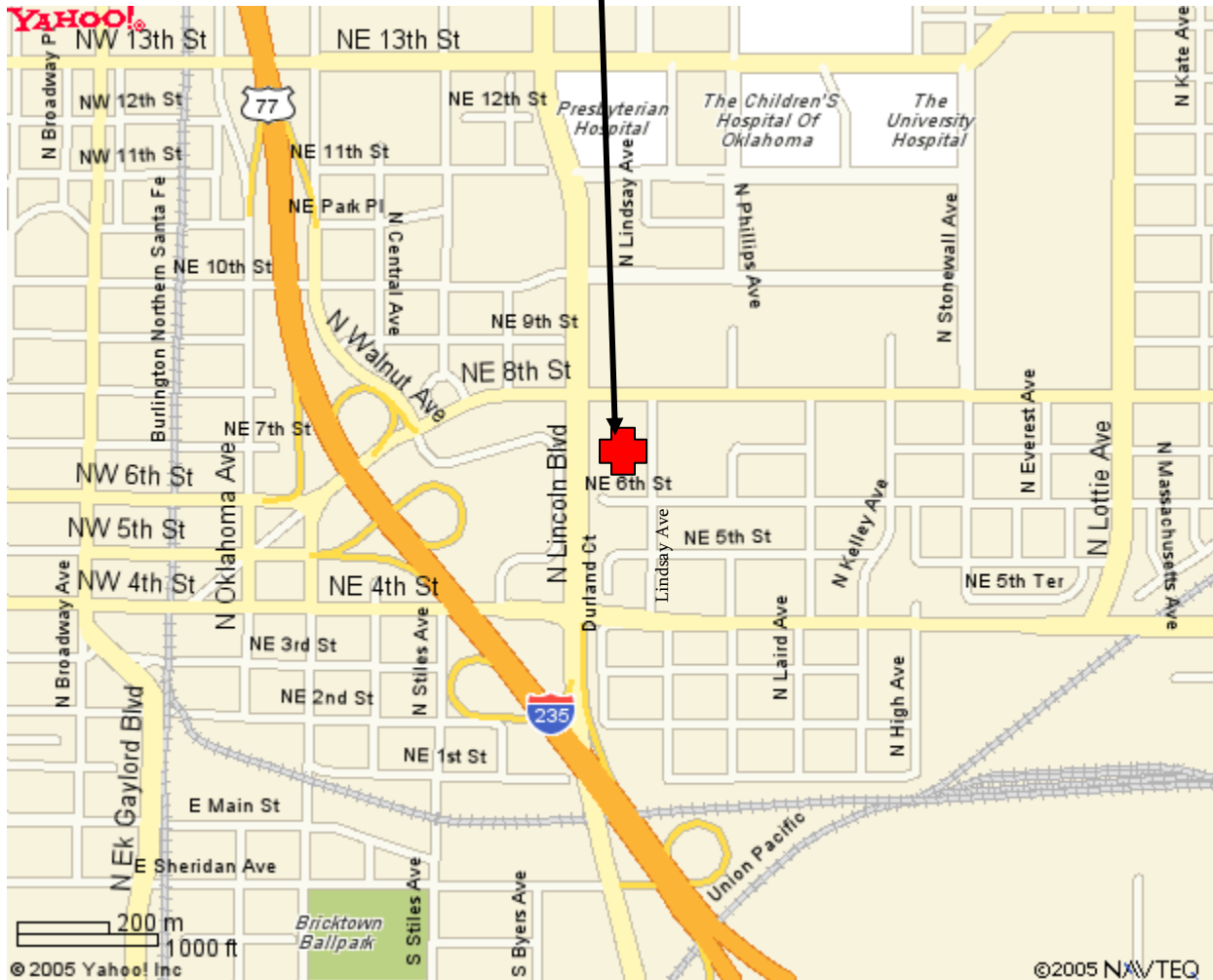
**We will begin at and return to the
